



The Executive MBA Program—spanning three campuses in Chicago, London, and Hong Kong—is designed to enhance students' general management skills through a strong understanding of fundamentals (in economics, statistics, accounting, psychology, and sociology). Our presence in Hong Kong—Asia's hub of finance and entrepreneurship—provides many opportunities for the exchange of ideas among students, faculty, alumni, and the international business community.

Program Format

Length of program: 21 months

Structure: 16 residential sessions lasting six days each (Monday through Saturday), with one morning and one afternoon class per day; 12 week-long sessions in Hong Kong, three sessions in Chicago, and one session in London

Size: Approximately 90 students

Study groups: Five to seven students meeting during session weeks and collaborating electronically to complete assignments, review class materials, and prepare for upcoming courses

Faculty and Curriculum

Courses are taught by University of Chicago Booth School of Business award-winning faculty, a community distinguished by its seven Nobel laureates. In addition to the general management curriculum, Executive MBA students may pursue a track of elective study in capital markets, corporate finance, entrepreneurship, marketing, strategy, or leadership and management to specialize in and deepen their knowledge in areas of particular interest for their careers. They are also offered a choice between two experiential capstone courses.

Career Services

Career Services is dedicated to supporting the lifelong career needs of all Chicago Booth students and alumni. The Career Services team for the Hong Kong campus works closely with students in the region, and career resources are also available in Chicago and London.

From self-assessment to offer negotiation, whether you are advancing within a firm or making a career transition, Career Services support is available to you for life. Wherever you are in your career, you can access Career Services to help you reach your professional goals.

Global Network

Application Process

Applications for 2017 are available online at **ChicagoBooth.edu/apply**. Admissions decisions are made on a rolling basis. Therefore, we recommend submitting your application as early as possible. Applications will not be considered by the admissions committee until all required application materials have been received.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Application form and essay
- Two letters of recommendation
- Curriculum vitae
- Official transcripts from all universities and colleges from which you have earned a degree
- US \$175 nonrefundable application fee
- GMAT, GRE, or Executive Assessment test score (unless you have been granted a waiver)*
- Ability to travel to Chicago, London, and Hong Kong

INTERVIEWS

An interview is required for admission to the program. Interviews will be granted on an invitation-only basis after the evaluation of a submitted application.

TUITION AND FEES

June 2017 cohort: HKD 1,265,000 (approximately USD \$162,000)

The program fees cover tuition, all books and materials, some meals, and hotel accommodations for three weeks in Chicago and one week in London.

Transportation to all locations and lodgings in Hong Kong is excluded. Special rates at hotels convenient to the campus are available.

Since 1998 the Trust has been awarding scholarships at the city's tertiary institutions to students who combine outstanding character, leadership, and academic performance with a strong commitment to serving the community. In a major strategic step forward in nurturing Hong Kong's most promising people, the Trust started offering scholarships at the University of Chicago Booth School of Business in Hong Kong to support aspiring leaders at nonprofit organizations in pursuing the Executive MBA Program. The program empowers students with a global vision, international network, and world-class education, thereby building the capacity of Hong Kong's social service sector to respond to increasingly complex social problems in the 21st century.

Qualifications for Scholarship Consideration

To qualify for the Hong Kong Jockey Club Chicago Booth Executive MBA Scholarship, candidates must:

- Work in or serve an NGO with tax exemption under section 88
 AND
- Be a Hong Kong permanent resident

Applicants will only receive a scholarship award once their application has been completed and submitted, and they have been formally accepted to the Executive MBA Program.

Scholarship value: Full tuition (US\$175 nonrefundable application fee is not included)

- Copy of Hong Kong Identity Card
- Scholarship essay
- Beneficiary recommendation (optional)
- Confirmed acceptance of Terms and Conditions (please refer to the Terms and Conditions on this page)

Deadline for scholarship application is January 27, 2017.

Your Chicago Booth admissions application must also be completed by this date.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Winners of Scholarship will be notified in writing and must accept the Scholarship by the deadline as specified in the award letter.
- If an award winner ("Scholar(s)") accept the Scholarship and the admissions offer of the Program, he/she will be required to pay an enrollment deposit of HKD40,000 to Chicago Booth within two weeks from the award letter to enrol in the Program. Chicago Booth will reimburse the Scholar for the enrollment deposit paid after the completion of the Kick-Off week in Chicago.
- If a Scholar withdraws from the Program before or during the Kick-Off week, the Scholarship will be withdrawn and the enrollment deposit will neither be refunded nor reimbursed.
- The Scholarship is conditional upon the Scholar being successfully enrolled in the Program for the academic year as set out in the award letter. Scholarships may not be deferred to future academic years. HKJC reserves the right to withdraw the Scholarship if the Scholar is subsequently found to be ineligible, could not satisfy any conditions attached to the admissions offer or these terms and conditions, or otherwise fails to be registered for the Program for the relevant academic year.
- The award amount will be deducted from the tuition invoices until the award is fully paid out.
- All awards are conditional upon satisfactory academic performance as required under the Program.
- The Scholarship is only applicable to the Executive MBA Program and cannot be transferred to other Chicago Booth MBA Programs.
- The award amount will cover tuitions, including all classes and teachings, transcript fee, all books and materials, some meals, and hotel accommodations for three weeks in Chicago and one week in London. Transportation to all locations and lodging in Hong Kong are excluded. Details of the items covered by the Scholarship will be set out in the award letter. No further financial support will be provided.
- Award recipients agree to be involved in community services for two years after completion of the Executive MBA Program.
